

One topic for 1 hour each evening to start with


- Build up time and topics each week




Studying – The Do's and Don'ts

- Levels 1-5 = Certificate
- Level 6 = Advanced/Higher Certificate
- Level 7 = Ordinary Degree
- Level 8 = Honours Degree/Higher Diploma
- Level 9 = Masters Degree/Post-Graduate Diploma
- Level 10 = Doctoral Degree

✓ CHECK THAT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT SUBJECTS AND LEVELS TO GET INTO A COURSE

THESE ARE CALLED THE MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

✓ CHECKING THE POINTS WILL ONLY GIVE YOU A ROUGH IDEA.

POINTS CAN CHANGE EACH YEAR

✓ PLCs DO NOT REQUIRE POINTS. THEY HAVE MINIMUM ENTRY

REQUIREMENTS AND CALL THE STUDENT FOR AN INTERVIEW

CAO stands for the Central Applications Office All applications to Higher Education Institutions (Universities/Colleges/Institutes of Technology) in the Republic of Ireland are made through the CAO CAO application forms are available online at www.cao.ie An application fee is charged see handout/school website for further details...
